

Aging and Disability Summit • Scholarship Application

The Summit Steering Committee is committed to making Colorado's Inaugural Aging and Disability Summit accessible to people from resource-limited settings and communities. We aim to serve those who, because of financial difficulty, wouldn't otherwise be able to attend.

Scholarship applications will be reviewed by a Scholarship Review Committee that includes members of the Aging and Disability community and an equal or smaller number of state staff. All identifying information will be removed from applications before they are sent to the Committee.

Due to restrictions with the conference budget, a limited amount of scholarship funding can be awarded. The Committee will carefully evaluate all applications with full commitment that no applicant is subjected to discrimination of any type. Scholarship dollars will be spread across as many applications as possible, but it is possible that some applications may be declined.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Applications must live in the State of Colorado
- Applicants must demonstrate how attending the conference will benefit them and/ or their community

The completed Scholarship Application Form must be received by the Scholarship Review Committee no later than 5:00 p.m. Mountain Standard Time, on Friday, October 12, 2012. No exceptions will be allowed. Scholarship applicants should receive a response from the Scholarship Review Committee on or before Wednesday, October 24, 2012.

Late and incomplete applications will not be considered. All applications must be submitted utilizing this form. Please type or print in block letters. Information that is illegible cannot be considered. Other material will not be accepted.
